Providing for your loved ones

You don't have to be wealthy to leave a legacy - even a small amount would provide something fun on the trip for a very deserving child. Did you know that just £400 would pay for a whole Group of children to have ice-cream, popcorn and drinks every day for the whole trip!



How to leave a gift to Dreamflight in your Will

Leaving a legacy is easier than you might think. A solicitor would be able to give you specific advice, or you could seek the help from organisations like Citizens Advice Bureau or Age UK.

Here are options that you could choose:

- a percentage of your estate (a residuary legacy after you have provided for your loved ones). This could be as little as 1%.
- a set amount (a pecuniary legacy)



At the time of writing, Gifts in Wills for charitable purposes are exempt from Inheritance Tax. As a registered charity, the value of any gift to Dreamflight is deducted from your estate before any liability to Inheritance Tax is calculated. This can be a useful way of bringing down the value of your estate and the size of the tax bill payable by your loved ones.
